The Need For TSC

Truck crash death and injury figures in the United States are staggering. National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) reports over 5,600 people lost their lives in large truck crashes last year, a stunning 13% increase over the previous year. On top of that, roughly 146,000 individuals are injured annually. In fatal crashes involving a large truck and passenger vehicle, 97 percent of fatalities are car occupants, according to the Insurance Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS). The annual taxpayer cost of truck crashes exceeds \$180 billion, imposing a steep economic drain on our society. The Truck Safety Coalition is devoted to advancing comprehensive solutions to stop the unnecessary and unacceptable carnage on our roads.


