Dear Mr. Graves:

As families and friends of people who were needlessly killed in truck crashes, we are writing to urge the American Trucking Associations (ATA) to scrap its current legislative agenda and stand with the public to support safety. Since you have become President and CEO of ATA, more than 48,000 people have died in large truck crashes in the United States between 2003 and 2013. To put this figure into perspective, large truck crash fatalities have exceeded the entire population of your hometown of Salina, Kansas. Moreover, over the last four years (2009-2013), truck crash fatalities have gone up 17 percent and injuries have increased 28 percent. Clearly the ATA should embark on a course correction and advocate for improving laws and safety protections which will address this unacceptable death and injury toll.

The ATA has been lobbying for an all-out assault on truck safety including: overturning state laws and forcing them to allow longer 33-foot double trailer trucks; pushing for heavier trucks on our already compromised infrastructure; extending already long work weeks for truck drivers to up to 82 hours per week; allowing teenagers to drive trucks weighing 80,000 pounds or more interstate; and, reducing the oversight and accountability of trucking companies by prohibiting the public from accessing critical data on their safety history.

Pushing Congress to hand over the keys to 18 to 20 year olds to drive across state lines is a prime example of an ATA proposal that will make our roads more dangerous and also belies public opinion. *USA Today, The New York Times*, the *Wilkes Journal-Patriot*, the *Montgomery Advertiser, The Capital Times* and other papers throughout the country have issued editorials opposing this proposal. In fact, in an interview with NPR in July, a trucking executive said he wouldn't hire teenagers because of safety concerns. It is a commonly known fact that teen drivers lack driving experience and are more likely to engage in risky behavior. Additionally, the fatal crash involvement rate of commercial motor vehicle (CMV) drivers increases as the age of the driver decreases. We urge you to withdraw support from this ill-conceived plan and instead support strong, comprehensive entry-level driver training requirements that ensure new drivers fully understand how to operate a large truck.

We also urge the ATA to join the numerous trucking companies that have committed to putting safety first and are opposing bigger and heavier trucks. Productivity, corporate responsibility and safety can be coexisting goals. The ATA is in a powerful position to demonstrate leadership

and commit to a type of "Vision Zero" plan for fatalities and injuries in truck crashes. Now is the time to stop the assault on truck safety and commit to advances that will save lives, protect our infrastructure and also reduce associated crash costs. Thank you for your consideration.
