Make a Bequest in Your Will or Trust:



If you already have a will or trust, contact your lawyer to amend it. If you don't have one yet, consider creating one for your legacy giving and other personal needs.

How: "I, [official name], of [city, state, ZIP], give, devise and bequeath to The Crash Foundation, Inc., DBA Truck Safety Coalition, 700 Pennsylvania Ave, Suite 200, Washington, DC 20003 [written amount or percentage of the estate] for its unrestricted use and purpose."

Why: Maintain current lifestyle, no immediate cost and gift is exempt from federal estate tax.

Name TSC as a Beneficiary in a Financial Asset:



If you have an asset, such as a retirement plan or life insurance policy, you can direct TSC to receive all or a portion of it.

How: Simply fill out the required form from your provider to "Add Beneficiary" and return as directed.

Why: Incredibly easy, does not require an attorney and gift is exempt from federal estate tax.

Gift Stock or Securities directly or via a Donor Advised Fund (DAF):



This is also a fairly simple process for those who already have stock and security assets or those who wish to invest in them soon. This works for any stocks, mutual funds, exchange traded funds, index funds, and even Donor Advised Funds (DAFs)!

How: Contact the Truck Safety Coalition (info@trucksafety.org) and we can provide you with simple step-by-step instructions provided by our wealth management firm.

Why: Similar to other options, it's very simple and your gift could potentially qualify for an income tax deduction and also help you avoid capital gains taxes on increased value assets.
